11	Brief Report of the event <sup>*3</sup>	Department of Public Health Dentistry of Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University organized an oral health screening program on 21 <sup>st</sup> April 2022 at Kota Khandewla Village, Gurugram in association with Publicity Team to celebrate the International Earth Day, 2022. International Earth Day is celebrated around the world on 22 <sup>nd</sup> April. This is important day that raises awareness about the environment and global commitment to make the planet better. The first Earth Day was proposed by John MC Connell in 1970. Now we have celebrated Earth Day, 2022 with the theme " <b>Invest in our planet</b> ". The Key point was to act in a bold way, innovate in broad way and implement in equitable manner. Keeping this mind Academic Association organised an oral health screening program to promote understanding of important environmental issues and how it is related to your general health and oral health. The Dental team took initiative under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head and Associate Dean) and Dr. Abhinav (Advisor, Innova 8 Oral Health Care). The Dental team was headed by Dr Meenakshi Chopra (Co-Advisor, Innova 8 Oral Health Care) along with 2 student members of Innova 8 Oral Health Care and 1 attendant. A total of 23 patients including 1 male and 22 females were examined. Patients who required complex dental treatment were referred to SGT University for further procedures. Oral health education was imparted to the people and motivated to plant more and more trees and use ecofriendly items to save our planet. The dental students appreciated the opportunity given to them to organize the activities and interact with patients at a community setting leading to improvement in their soft skills and approach towards patients in an outreach location.
