The Faculty of Law, SGT University has established the *Centre for Judicial Services* to provide coaching for Judicial Examinations of various States. We believe that it will benefit law students by providing them with focused guidance and support.

OBJECTIVE OF CENTRE FOR JUDICIAL SERVICES:

Judicial Service Examinations are highly competitive and require rigorous preparation. Through the establishment of the *Centre for Judicial Services*, the Faculty of Law aims to create an environment where students can receive specialized coaching, access to study materials, mock tests, and interactive sessions that will enhance their understanding of legal concepts and improve their exam-taking skills focusing on both the substantive and procedural aspects of the law, as well as offering strategies for effective time management and answer presentation during Preliminary round and Mains examinations.

The *Centre for Judicial Services* operates in harmony with the University's existing academic programs. Our intention is to complement the University's efforts in nurturing well-rounded legal professionals who are not only academically competent but also well-prepared for the challenges of the Judicial Service Examinations and also create a well-built Alumni for the Faculty of Law, SGT University.

STRUCTURE OF THE COURSE

1. Course duration would be 09 months.
2. Regular students of the Faculty of Law currently studying in BA LL.B, BBA LL.B, LL.B and LL.M can register for the Centre for Judicial Services.
3. Selection of students is done on the basis of two stages of screening test i.e., Objective test and Subjective test followed by the interview.
4. There would be 40 lectures of 2 hours duration for each subject.
5. Weekly MCQ test series.
6. Essay-type answer writing practice for main examinations.
7. Study material for the students of this course.

COURSES COVERED:

1. Law (Substantive and Procedural)
2. Drafting of Complaint/Written Statement/Charge framing/Judgment Writing

3. Language Paper including Precis Writing/Translation
4. Essay writing
5. General Knowledge, General Science.
